Chairman, Benjamin Brown called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Chairman, Benjamin Brown called for public comments with no response.

MINUTES:

The minutes of the Board of Supervisors February 2, 2021 regular meeting, were approved as presented by Supr. Lettich, second by Supr. Stoneroad. Motion carried.

PAYMENT OF INVOICES:

OTHER BUSINESS:

Reliance Hose Company No. #1

Chairman Brown recognized Ryan Romberger, President; Tammy Keisling, Vice President; and Fred Dill, Fire Chief to present the 2020 year-end report of the fire company. The Supervisors were provided with hard copies of various reports prior to the meeting. After a recap of the reports, accomplishments and future goals, a brief question period was held.

Stormwater Exemption Request:

A plan requesting exemption of stormwater management requirements was submitted. As per the 2/10/2021 revised stormwater exemption plan, the property owner of parcel 66-010-096 is proposing to construct a single-family dwelling, carport and driveway creating 2,504 sq. ft. of new impervious coverage. Also, applying a deduction of 1,605 sq.ft. for the removal of a single-family dwelling that transpired on the parcel several years ago. After his review, the township engineer has commented the applicant must submit volume controls and a SWM site plan. Since there was no one present to represent the plan, it is the consensus of the Supervisors to table a decision until more information is available.

Elizabethville Area Authority:

The engineer for the Elizabethville Area Authority is gathering information to submit the Chapter 94 report to DEP on behalf of the Authority. Part of the preparation of the report is to inquire if the Township is aware of any new land development, occurring within the next five years, that will require new connections or taps to the Authority's existing wastewater collection system or new sewer line extension. It was noted, the Answers Pet Food Processing Facility will require public sewer connection in that time frame.

After brief discussion, it is the consensus of the Supervisors to include President's Day as an additional holiday for employees, beginning 2022.
