- I. Call to Order Chairman Shadle called the meeting to order at 7:13. Evan

 letter stating the borough's needs and come to the May meeting.
- V. New Business -- Chairman Shadle reported that the owner of the AD Coal Breaker on the north side of the Wiconisco Creek was interested in having his property reclaimed through Dauphin County and developed as a park to include a canoe launch and handicapped and elderly fishing access. The owner, Mr. Andrew Drebitko, originally intended three acres of the nine acre site to be so set aside. The question arose as to whether the other six acres could be purchased for trails and fields. Evan Williams volunteered to contact Andy MacAllister from county to explore the possibilities.
- VI. Adjournment On a motion by Evan Williams, seconded by Kevin Hoch, the meeting adjourned at 7:50. Next meeting will be May 18, 2005.
